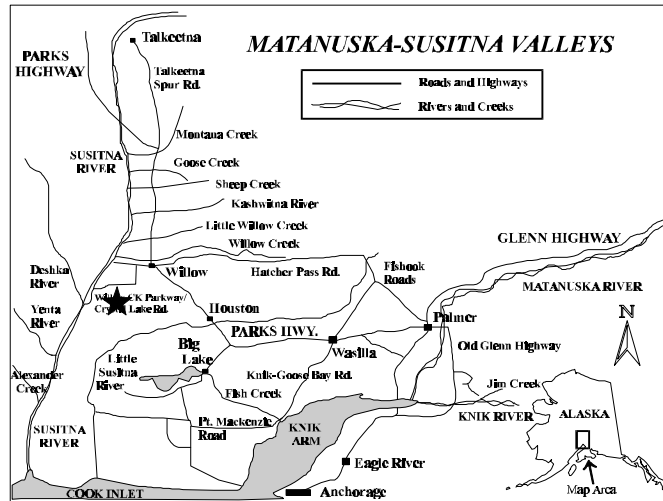
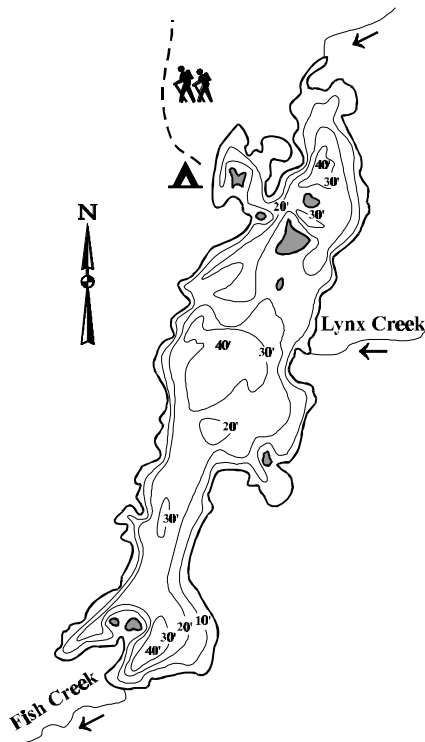

RED SHIRT LAKE PUBLIC ACCESS: Mile 67.3 Parks Hwy. West on Nancy Lake Parkway 6.6 miles to parking area just before South Rolly Lake Campground. A marked trail 3.0 miles traverses the ridge west of Red Shirt Lake ending at 10 remote campsites. Access can also be by floatplane. State Parks maintains 4 public use cabins on the lake. Check with State Parks for information at (907) 745-3975 or check their web site at: <http://www.dnr.state.ak.us/parks/parks.htm> **NOTE:** Limited public access. Please respect private property. Keep lake and access sites free of litter.

STATEWIDE HARVEST SURVEY DATA: None available. Redshirt Lake is included in the total numbers of Nancy Lake State Recreation Area.

COMMENTS: Redshirt Lake once supported a rainbow trout population, but with the migration of northern pike into the ecosystem the rainbow trout have been all but wiped out. Redshirt Lake has now become a popular northern pike fishery. The major outlet, Fish Creek, is on the south end eventually draining into Flat Horn Lake, then the Susitna River. Two inlets are Lynx Creek on the east and an inlet from South Rolly Lake on the north.
